Description

Magnificently located since 1667 on the banks of the Neuville River, Langlois et Fils farm is one of Quebec's oldest. This alone makes it a valuable stop on your journey. Such a record of longevity speaks volumes about the determination and adaptability of the farm over the decades. The cultivation of Neuville sweet corn is an excellent example of the dynamism the Langlois family and other growers have brought to the industry. They have even obtained a reserved designation for their high-quality produce. The farm stand has been open to customers since 1960 to sell their produce and raise awareness of their field work. Over time, this has become even more important, especially with the growing emphasis on buying locally and using short distribution channels. Proud of their agricultural heritage, the Langlois family enthusiastically shares their history and various hand-picked fruits and vegetables. Along with the many fresh and tasty products processed on-site, Médé Langlois, along with his sister Nathalie and brother Daniel, provides an informative and colourful lesson in agriculture as worthy representatives of the 11th generation of the family.
