How would you like to go back to a time when the miller played a crucial role in the lives of the local people? That's what the Moulins de l'Isle-aux-Coudres have in store for you. It is the only site in North America where you can find a charming miller's house, a historic water mill from 1825, and a magnificent windmill built in 1836, all in one place. The visit promises to be an unforgettable experience in an exceptional setting. These two architectural marvels, restored to their original character in the 1980s and now fully functional, are sure to inspire awe. Experience transforming raw grain into fine flour, as the skilled miller demonstrates how he grinds the grains using traditional stone millstones. Exhibitions, films, photos and objects will tell you more about the life of the islanders, their traditions and the history of the mills and their millers. On-site, guests can enjoy a children's play area, admire the traditional bread oven, picnic or relax amidst the immense greenery. Stop by the shop for freshly ground flour and other local products.
