Located in Hébertville, Saguenay-Lac-Saint-Jean, TournevenT has been practising organic farming in this boreal zone since 2008. This family-owned business specializes in the production of oilseeds, garlic, and pulses. It is one of the few oil mills in Quebec that produces extra-virgin cold-pressed flax, hemp, canola, and camelina oils from the northern terroir. When you visit the site, you can enjoy the breathtaking view of the plains surrounded by the mountains of the Réserve faunique des Laurentides (Laurentides Wildlife Reserve). The ÉCONOMUSÉE® provides various opportunities to learn about the process of oil production, from earth to table. With guided tours, tastings, and hands-on "make your own oil" workshops, visitors can immerse themselves in the world of oil production. The peaceful and serene environment is surrounded by nature, emphasizing the importance of the environment in the production of oil. This is where "slow tourism" really comes into its own.
